Baine's owners had moved to Virginia and had not been able to take him with them, so they had left him with a relative. The relative could not keep him and surrendered him to Animal Control in March where he waited and waited, until May, when NPR rescued him. The owner had been desperately looking for Baine since they were now able to keep him and hoped they could have him back. Luckily for them, Echo aka Baine, had not been

adopted. Once the foster called him by his real name, "Baine," he lit up!

Our dedicated foster was willing to drive over 100 miles to meet halfway in Kentucky to reunite him with his forever family. We love a Happily Ever After!

Turkey Bacon Treats for Molly

Preheat oven to 350F. Coat 2 baking sheets with non-stick spray.

Chop 8 oz of uncooked turkey bacon coarsely Mix well with 2 cups amaranth flour, 1/2 cup warm water, & 2 large eggs.





Drop tablespoons of dough onto baking sheet about 1/2 inch apart. Bake for 15-18 minutes. Cool for 30 minutes. Place in air tight container in fridge for 3 days or freeze up to 3 months.
